John spoke of Jesus as the Lamb of God – the sacrificial lamb - who would take away the SIN of the world.
Jesus was like all men in every respect except that His spirit was not born dead in sin because He was conceived, not by a man, but by God, the Holy Spirit.

The sacrifice of Jesus has made it possible for all men to be redeemed from sin and death, spiritually, mentally, emotionally, and physically.

Session Three: What Does This Mean For You?

"For you have been born again not of seed which is perishable, but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God." 1 Peter 1:23 NASB

Jesus made it possible for all men to be completely redeemed and completely freed from sin and death, forgiven, cleansed, and freed, - NEW!
In the beginning, man walked and talked with God. Communication and fellow-
ship were complete, just as God designed and purposed.
By accepting Jesus as our Savior and Lord, and by acknowledging His sacrifice
for us, our communication and fellowship with God is restored.

When we receive Jesus as our Savior and Lord, we now have a new spirit that is born of God, that is alive unto God, and now, God becomes our Father.
Not only is communication restored, and family relationship establishedbut fellowship and partnership with God are restored.
Furthermore, our new spirit is an eternal gift. That's what Jesus meant when He said, "eternal life".
1 Peter 1:23

Session Four: Salvation

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish, but have eternal life." John 3:16 NASB
Romans 10:9
When a person believes that:
1) Jesus died on the Cross, to pay for our sin and sins
2) Jesus was buried, and remained there, in the grave, for three days 3) Jesus rose from the dead
Then we are indeed saved, redeemed, and born again of the Spirit.
This new spirit teaching is a personal invitation to a relationship with the God of the universe, who now is your Father.
