The actual work of salvation is giving you a new identity.
This is essential in your understanding, or you will relegate yourself to being damaged goods.

How you view yourself matters it will dictate how you live.

Session 2: THE BATTLE

Section 2A: Satan's Work On God's Children

We are all engaged in a battle.
Satan is depending on your ignorance.
2 Corinthians 2:11
Satan will not try to come in and overthrow you on his first encounter.

The progression that satan uses most often is to get you to fall in a small area first.
1 Corinthians 15:33
Next is the lie that comes straight from the pit of hell: "These small transgressions are really not a problem at all. You can handle it."
People will set up false limits to their sin.
Once satan has made inroads into your soul, he can now begin to work on many areas at once.

When a child of God has become accustomed to tolerating sins in his or her life, there is an inevitable change that will begin to happen in the soul.

Section 2B: Demonic Strategies Against Individuals

A strategy is, in fact, a long-term plan.
Isolation is a long-term strategy the enemy uses.
Whereas a temptation is more of a tactic.
Tactics are used in the moment and are designed to get an instant response.
In Luke 4, we see Jesus being tempted by the devil.

Interestingly enough, Adam and Eve were tempted in a very similar way.
These tactics and strategies are designed to affect your soul in a subtle way.
Understanding the difference between strategies and tactics might very well be the difference in whether you are successful at resisting the enemy, or not.

Session 3: BATTLE WON

Our enemy needs us to not recognize there is a battle raging.
Satan definitely does not want us to recognize an essential aspect of this battle: it is a won war.
Satan wants you to operate from a place of perceived defeat.
This knowledge-based belief system will cause you to operate in a God-confident faith.
Numbers 13

Section 4B: Releasing Unforgiveness

Principle: God forgives. You're made in His image, and you are designed to forgive and not hold on to unforgiveness.
Principle: If you don't forgive others, God cannot forgive you because He is bound by His word.
Matthew 18

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Section 4D: Mindsets

Many times we need deliverance from mindsets that we have developed over time.
These mindsets cannot be something you tolerate in your life.
Mindsets are against your purpose.
Mindsets are detrimental to your position in this life and the assignment from God for your life.
Mindsets will cripple you and cause you to back down from the calling on your life.

How do you get deliverance from mindsets? Romans 12.	
Start by focusing on what the Bible actually says about people in general, and you specifically.	
Romans 8	
Do not allow people to speak anything that looks like death to you.	

Session 5: STAYING FREE

Section 5A: Staying Free

Question: How do you know when and if the deliverance worked?

- "Clarity comes when there was confusion previously."
- "The feeling of being overwhelmed by insurmountable odds is gone, and hope is restored."
- "Things that used to trigger me or send me down a certain emotional path do not affect me anymore."

•	"I have an assurance that comes from knowing that God is who He says He is, and does what He says He does."		
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- "You will see the fruit of a changed life."
- "You will see a difference in how you are compelled vs. how you are tempted."
- "You will enter into discipleship more deeply, without previous hindrances."
- "You will sense the cleansing that comes from walking in the light and confessing before God. Isolation is broken and you are reconnected to fellowship with God and others."

Section 5B: Setting Up Shields
