- Example of Biblical submission to a set of protocols (etiquette) that was not for all people

- **Jer. 35:1-19**
- **Luke 7**

- Recognition that you are representing the Lord, His Bride and your church

- That you know your leaders' heart, how they work, what they expect

- **1 Thess. 5:12-13 NKJV**
